**Regina v Maurice John KIRK**

This note updates the CAO summary, dated 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010.

The appellant's case was originally listed on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2011.

On 11<sup>th</sup> February 2011, the presiding judge, Lord Justice Goldring, refused the appellant's application for leave to give evidence and call two other witnesses, HHJ Cooke QC & Francis Werren.

On 18<sup>th</sup> February, following an application from the appellant, Lord Justice Goldring directed that the appeal come out of the list in view of the appellant's physical condition. On the 1<sup>st</sup> March, it was further directed that the case be re-listed in 28 days and that the appellant must attend or his appeal would be dismissed.

Lord Justice Goldring also indicated that he did not propose to make an order for disclosure of the court logs and tapes of proceedings from Cardiff Crown Court on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2009 and 24<sup>th</sup> June 2010, medical information supplied to the CPS within those proceedings, and Multi-Agency Public Arrangement minutes, for which the appellant had applied.
