Re: R v Maurice Kirk - Alleged Harrassment

Although we are not instructed to act for Mr Kirk in respect of this matter he has asked us to fax the Court in order to ensure that you are aware that he has been on hunger strike as a consequence of the Court and Prosecution failing to provide him with relevant documents, in particular documents relating to his status within the prison and a change to remand to convicted status when there has been no Sentencing Hearing.

He also wishes to make the Court aware that seventeen officers were mobilised in order to transfer him to the punishment block at the prison. Such "overkill" appearing to suggest a level of risk that is entirely inappropriate.

The Court would be aware that Mr Kirk has yet to be provided with any medical reports making reference to an alleged brain tumour, although Dr. [REDACTED] made extensive reference to this alleged condition at a Court Hearing where, seemingly, Dr [REDACTED] was proposing that Mr Kirk be Sectioned under the Mental Health Act. We understand that the relevant Health Authority insists that all medical reports have been disclosed to Mr Kirk although, plainly, Mr Kirk reasonably believes that there must be a report or reports making reference to an alleged brain tumour in order for Dr [REDACTED] to be able to make such references before the Court.

We are informed by Mr Kirk that when he was first remanded in custody this was despite the Crown Prosecution Service making no objection to him being granted Bail.

In the circumstances we would be grateful if you could please provide us with the District Judge's reasons for failing to give Mr Kirk his Bail in order that we and Counsel may prepare a properly Plead Bail Application in due course.
