I have now had confirmation from Morgan Cole solicitors that they would like the Crown Prosecution Service to make representations on behalf of Dr [REDACTED] opposing your application to vary the Restraining Order.

As the application is opposed, it would be wise for you to bring evidence to court of anything you rely on. For example you mentioned at the previous hearing that the Restraining Order is preventing you from receiving treatment at [REDACTED] that has been recommended and offered to you by doctors. This is not accepted by Dr [REDACTED] and the Local Health Board, so any evidence that you can produce to support this will be important for you to produce. The Local Health Board's position is that you have not been offered or recommended for any treatment or assessment by them. It would assist if you could specify in advance of the hearing the name of any doctor who has offered or recommended you for treatment or assessment, the nature of the treatment or assessment offered and the date when this offer was made. If you are prepared to do this it may prevent the hearing having to be further adjourned for the LHB to produce rebuttal evidence. Of course, if you have been offered or recommended for any treatment or assessment by a different Local Health Board, then the restraining order as it stands would not prevent you from receiving this.

Dr [REDACTED] has also expressed concern that the Restraining Order does not preclude you from contacting

the [REDACTED]. As this is the professional role and address of Dr [REDACTED] he would like to apply to the court for the Order to be varied to restrain you from contacting the [REDACTED] expressly and has requested, through his solicitors, that the Crown Prosecution Service makes this application at the above hearing.
