

## **Witness Statement**

On 6<sup>th</sup> June 1995 I returned to 175 Cowbridge Road West, Cardiff, consisting of Mr Kirk's proposed veterinary surgery under construction and our flat situated above it.

Both Alison and I were locked out because our front door was barricaded by a locked roller shutter.

I was at the front of the building when my girlfriend's father, then Chief Inspector Brian Jenner of St Athan, arrived in his car with his wife. He assessed the situation with Sergeant Roe of Ely police station and called for more police to attend.

My parents both came, but on foot, at the same time and possibly supplied the sledge hammer, used to break in, if it was not in the van with the police who came later.

I then 'gained entry' to the flat with the police and retrieved my property.

I lost at least £2000 worth of property due to my eviction.

I am willing to give evidence in any court.
