At 4pm on Tuesday 6th June 1995 I was on duty at Ely Police Station when as a result of a conversation with Mr. GAFFER. I attended with him at 175 Cambridge Road West, ELY. The premises is a detached building the downstairs of which was in process of being converted into a Veterinary Surgery. I was unable to gain access to the upstairs, The rollershutter doors at the front being secured from the inside and the access door from the surgery being locked. At the left hand side of the premises I saw a large amount of furniture and personal possession which had been thrown there in a heap. These items were identified to me by Mr. GAFFER as being his. I made enquiries with the staff at the surgery and left.

At 9pm the same day I returned again with Mr. GAFFER where he

in my presence forced open the roller shutter doors. I went upstairs with him, I noticed that the electrics and water were turned off, floorboards had been pulled up, there were no carpets on the floors, the premises were at that time not fit for reasonable habitation without some professional work being carried out. Mr. GAGG removed a quantity of the furniture and personal property from the side of the house and took it into the flat we all then left.

At 4.10pm on Monday 3rd July 1995 I attended at Barry Police Station together with PC ROCHE 3100 after we interviewed Mr. Maurice Kirk in relation to damage to property and Tenancy offences. The interview was tape recorded a copy of which is produced for the Court EXHIBIT no. Ref. no PDR 1. The interview was concluded at 4.29 pm.
